

Pordenone, Largo Cervignano Park

The Park is characterized by an irregular perimeter determined by the individual houses and the condominium complexes bordering the area itself.

Peculiarity of this vast green space is the natural altimetric conformation, which in particular near the outcropping of the canal, gives an important naturalistic connotation, reinforced by the presence of numerous spontaneous species, of arboreal, herbaceous and shrubby type.

A figure to note is the presence of extensive meadows that adapt to the modelling of the land, resulting in a pleasant landscape perception.

In the past, the park was the object of a project that had as its purpose the creation of paths, rest areas and equipment, signed by the German landscape architect Ania Werner.
